WHEREAS, in Florida, small businesses are able to grow and thrive across all industries, creating jobs and driving innovation in the state, including nearly 27,000 manufacturing establishments, 80% of which have 20 or fewer employees, and more than 46,000 small businesses in the life sciences industry; and

WHEREAS, FloridaCommerce promotes economic prosperity for Florida's small businesses, administering programs that promote access to capital, technical assistance, and business management training, as well as invaluable resources to the state's small business employers; and

WHEREAS, SelectFlorida assists Florida small businesses in expanding into markets across the globe, and in 2024, supported 1,634 Florida businesses in generating more than \$765 million in actual and expected export sales.
